



Steven E. Taylor Sr.

September 14, 1957 - June 26, 2022

It is with great sorrow that the family of Mr. Steven Edward Taylor, Sr., 64, announces his passing on June 26, 2022, following a brief illness. After an evening of music, fellowship, laughter, and prayer, Steve passed away peacefully at his home in Silver Spring, MD. He will be lovingly remembered by Judith, his wife of nearly 38 years, his son Steven, Jr., his Princess Girl Simone, and his two grandchildren, Maxwell and Judah.

Steve worked for Montgomery College Facilities for over 35 years, holding the title of Building and Grounds Manager at the time of his death.

Steve was a fervent and devoted member of Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc. He served the Fraternity in many different capacities from the time of his initiation into Alpha Chapter in 1979 to leading the effort and helping to charter Montgomery County, MD's Alumni Chapter, Tri-Sigma, in 1996. Up until the onset of his illness, Steve held several offices representing his chapter at the local, regional, and national levels.
